Benny's One Small Push

When a job feels big, point to one next step.

This job feels big.



Try one part



Ask for help



Change the plan



Take a short pause



GROWN-UP NOTE

Let your child point. You do not need to explain every choice or use every page.

Look at the Parts

Benny did not need one bigger push. He looked at the separate parts.

MOVE FIRST



What small part can move first?

Point, draw, or place a sticky note here.

BUILD TOGETHER



What part could use another Builder?

Point, draw, or place a sticky note here.

PARK FOR LATER



What part can wait for now?

Point, draw, or place a sticky note here.

USE ONLY WHAT HELPS

Talking or pointing is enough. The blank spaces are optional, not an assignment.

Ask the Crew

Point to the kind of help that fits this moment.



ROCKY

A slow breath

One bump does not have to become the whole road.



DANNY

Help with one part

I can carry one part with you.



BENNY

The next push together

Maybe we can take the next step together.
